






### **Small Group Discussion**

What is a "Doctor of the Church"?


- A rare title: only 37 saints so honored; as of 01 Nov, Newman is the 38<sup>th</sup>
- Their teaching is judged exceptionally important for Christians across time and cultures for 1) eminent doctrine, 2) outstanding holiness of life, and 3) an official proclamation by the Church (ordinarily by the pope)

God has created me to do Him some definite service; He has committed some work to me which He has not committed to another.


I have my mission—I never may know it in this life, but I shall be told it in the next. ...

I shall do good, I shall do His work Therefore I will trust Him. ...


If I am in sickness, my sickness may serve Him; in perplexity, my perplexity may serve Him; if I am in sorrow, my sorrow may serve Him. ...
